### The "Labyrinth"

Our most popular and versatile challenge which takes its inspiration from TV's "Crystal Maze" or "Krypton Factor", but is for teams rather than individuals... The 'Labyrinth' is the 'collective' name for a series of 30-minute physical and intellectual challenges, aimed at team building with an emphasis on fun and problem solving rather than physical exertion - although each does require a high degree of co-operation between team members. Even better, we can directly relate these to the types of skills used in the office environment, providing genuine "take home" value.



### Motorised Challenges

### It's A Knockout'

The M&MR 'It's A Knockout' is a highly colourful and superbly impressive challenge for participants and spectators alike. If you enjoy competing on huge custom-built inflatables or dashing around in wacky costumes, this concept is definitely for you. With a host of great music and colourful props a real party atmosphere is guaranteed for everyone.



### Human Table Football

We can arrange a "World Cup" tournament like no other – each team provides five players from their squad for a straightforward football match... except each person is strapped to a bar "becoming" a table football player. Unlike competitors, our kit includes an inflatable base, increasing safety & fun (football + bouncy castle in one!)



### "School Sports Day"

It's 'back to school' with our hilarious take on the classic school sports day. Sure, the eggs, spoons & sacks will feature – but so too will an array of hilarious, crazy challenges!

### Ryder Cup Challenge

A sporting challenge with a twist! A series of splendid head-to-head "golf" related challenges designed to get bodies and teams working together. (Let's qualify that: "loosely related"!)



### Highland Games

The M&MR Highland Games takes elements of our other sporting challenges, adds others, and the whole event is themed to give it a distinctly Scottish flavour. Guests will be split into "clans" (The McArDOS, MacRamès, McSpreaders, Clan Dudnos etc.) each of which will have their own tartan for their "chief" to wear, as well as creating a banner to plant on the field of "combat". Each clan will be "piped" onto the field, their chief aiming to lead his team to glorious victory.

### A Hard Day's Knight

We challenge each "band of brothers" to earn more "groats" than the rest by competing in a multi-activity day with a medieval flavour. As the pennants flutter & flags fly, each band meets the others in "mortal" competition through a series of carefully selected activities, culminating in a head-to-head Grand Finale between all teams. A variation on this is our Knight School! Suitable for anyone (whether you can ride or not), you will be taught basic jousting skills and mounted games, have your own coat of arms, learn basic choreographed fights & even earn the title of "Company Robin Hood" by splitting the arrow!





### **“Wacky Races” – Pedal Car Spectacular!**

Remember Dastardly, Muttley & Penelope Pitstop? Well here's your chance to re-enact the plot as you attempt – in one of six teams – to race each other “around the globe” to become the “World's Wackiest Racer”. This challenge involves the teams assembling and racing a pedal powered full sized kart. In addition, these karts need to look as much like the original vehicles as possible (e.g. the Boulder Mobile, Creepy Coupe, Compact Pussycat and Mean Machine). The closer the vehicles look to the originals, the further up the track they will start... Drat, drat & double drat!!!!

### **Agility Dogs, Owls & Ferret Racing**

A three-for-one as firstly you are given the chance to have your own mini-Crufts with trained agility dogs followed by “The Great Ferret Race” as points are gambled on the antics of Polecat Pete, Mighty Malcolm and friends! In between, you'll get the opportunity to learn a bit of falconry as you test your nerves calling a Barn Owl to tether.



### **Cyber Tag**

This unique outdoor infra-red combat system is suitable for all; it can be played in the woods or rough terrain. It is ideal to run purely as a fun activity or, because of its versatile programming, can be used as the heart of complex problem solving team challenge. The system is safe (like paintballing without the pain!), clean & environmentally friendly!



### **Learn To Play Polo**

Experience the excitement and exhilaration of the “Sport of Kings” for yourselves! Suitable for anyone (whether you can ride or not). All you need is a sense of fun and adventure as you try to win the “Prince of Wales Cup” and avoid the losers' title: “Right Proper Charlies”!

### **The Spying Game**

Forget the ‘standard’ spy days – this is a bespoke event which utilises not only totally UNIQUE challenges, but the local community get involved too! In “Charlie's Angels: Full Throttle”, teams earn clues according to how well they perform as a team in a series of driving/shooting challenges; the popular theme not only provides a “raison d'être” for everybody but it will also increase the fun and “buy in” of the whole group.

Take some of the finest elements of “Gosford Park”, “Upstairs Downstairs” or The Shooting Party, and puts them together into an activity day with a difference.
